

# Our Continued Safety Covid Safety Precautions

Calvary Church Family and Friends,

We here at Calvary believe that keeping everyone safe is our top priority. The latest Covid surge is cause for concern - while this new variant is much less severe, more like a cold or mild flu, but also spreads



much faster. We have people in our families and in our communities without access to a vaccine, specifically small children. Even though it is mild for most children, our local hospitals and health care systems are completely slammed.
