

Wherefore, most loving God - we set before you this table - in praise and in thanksgiving to you and to Christ Jesus - who, on the eve of his death, took bread, and gave you thanks as we do now give you thanks for the bread that you give to us, and broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "take and eat, this my body, broken for you." We remember too, how when the meal was over, he took the cup, the cup of blessing, and having given you thanks, gave it his disciples, saying "take and drink; this is my blood, the blood of a new covenant for the forgiveness of sins, poured out for many"... As often as you do this, do it in remembrance of me."

Almighty God, whose people are knit together in one mystic communion, we pray you to send your Holy Spirit upon us and upon this bread and this cup - that they may be for us the body and the blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Grant that we may we rejoice in the holy people of every time and place, and with them know your forgiveness and love and grow in grace as we advance in years. 


